List of disadvantages that can be considered under the Multiple Disadvantages objective.

This list is not exhaustive and individuals or families could experience other disadvantages that would also bring them in scope of the new data-sharing powers.

- 1. The individual, or an individual in the household, carrying out, or being subject to anti-social behaviour;
- 2. The individual being, or the household being, a care leaver;
- 3. The individual being, or the household being, a child in need;
- 4. Disability, including learning disability;
- 5. Domestic violence;
- 6. A failure to regularly attend school;
- 7. Financial exclusion:
- 8. Homelessness
- 9. Ill-health, including mental ill-health;
- 10. Offending by the individual or by an individual in the household;
- 11. Substance misuse;
- 12. Unemployment

The UK government has provided definitions of these terms in the draft Digital Government (Disclosure of Information) Regulations 2017, available here. These terms and definitions may be adapted to ensure they are suitable for bodies delivering services in Wales.
