To whom it may concern

I have been a resident of Anglesey for twenty-five years and my response to the NDF Consultation is as follows:

Anglesey's beautiful landscape, with increasingly protected areas of natural wildlife habitat have contributed greatly to a thriving tourism industry. The proposed onshore wind energy developments would serve to ruin the landscape as an amenity and destroy natural habitats; thus blighting the island for its numerous visitors from all over the world.

Wind farms sited on agricultural land also reduce opportunities for food production:

Anglesey is comprised of farming communities.

The detriment to the physical and mental health of people unfortunate enough to live anywhere near large wind turbines has been well documented.

Large wind turbines are not efficient and use vast resources in their construction, running and demolition. Nuclear power, tidal power and domestic-scale solar power are, together, more acceptable, reliable and efficient sources of energy for Anglesey than industrial-scale wind turbines.
