I am writing with concern about the NDF target of 70% of electricity from renewables by 2030 purely from onshore wind and solar and the impact this will have on huge parts of rural Wales.

As of November 12 the National Marine Plan supports offshore wind, tidal range, tidal stream and wave power although no target is given. Surely this must affect the 70% target?

Perhaps so much that land based generation becomes obsolete? I urge you to combine the NDF and NMP into a single renewables target with a timeline to achieve that target.

At the moment your consultants report contains an appendix which states that the 15 priority areas will generate 95TWh of power from 20% of Welsh land and this does not take into account the NMP's marine energy. This is also ten times more than is needed.

You are the guardians of some of the most beautiful places on earth. Please consider how your actions will affect the rural people whose homes and businesses lie in the priority areas.

The problems of climate change must be addressed but not without considering all the options and their impacts.
