Enabling Natural Resources and Wellbeing	Supports projects that make improvements to natural resources in residential areas delivering benefits for people, businesses and their communities	£16,500,000

Co-operation and Supply Chain Development Scheme (CSDS) – (Anti-microbial Resistance)	The Anti-microbial Resistance (AMR) programme will work with animal keepers and vets to keep antibiotics effective for future generations. The programme also considers environmental aspects of AMR control.	£4,000,000
CSDS – (Pilot Actions for Community Cohesion & Green Recovery Support)	To continue to support the re-purposing of community cohesion activities through fostering innovation, pilot activities, optimising digitalisation.	£1,000,000
CSDS - (Innovative Approaches & Collaborative Growing)	Encourage and stimulate innovative approaches and collaborative opportunities in the horticulture sector.	£2,000,000
CSDS – (Pilot Action for Green Growth & Circular Economy)	Supports pilot actions to enable a whole supply-chain approach to be taken. Adding value to and embedding the sense of place and cultural heritage of Wales through processing and marketing of non-Annex I products	£1,000,000
CSDS – (Food Tourism)	Aims to kick start the food and visitor economy of Wales through co-operation between operators in farming, food and tourism and through supporting actors in the food service hospitality sector.	£3,000,000
CSDS (Food – Covid Recovery Plan)	Aims to develop innovative ways for using primary products, particularly but not exclusively food and wool.	£3,500,000
CSDS - (Community Transport)	To provide support for local community transport schemes	£2,400,000
CSDS (Round 6)	To provide support to businesses, organisations and communities to increase their resilience by tackling issues such as rural poverty, financial sustainability, climate change and the environment, in-work poverty and social exclusion.	£2,970,000
