Powys CC	Powys Visitor Experience Improvement Project. The Project focuses on three key visitor locations in Powys; Brecon, Llandrindod Wells and Lake Vyrnwy. Each location will make improvements enabling visitors to orientate themselves more effectively upon arrival in the areas, and more easily locate and access key visitor assets.	210,400

Cyngor Gwynedd	Aros-fan The 'Aros-fan' project will upgrade assets such as public car parks in 6 destinations across Gwynedd to develop a network of locations that will create legitimate provision for 'overnight' parking and sleeping throughout the year for the purpose of motor homes in Gwynedd.	240,000
Cyngor Gwynedd	Parc Gwledig Padarn, Llanberis. The project will make improvements to the car park at Glyn area and include EV charging points, cycle shelters, outdoor equipment washing area and groundworks.	250,000

	Improvements will be made to this popular destination and include mini golf, play equipment, green Infrastructure including E-bike charging points, water play infrastructure, bandstand seating, interpretation boards and ramped access between levels of the park.	
Flintshire CC	<p>Parks for All.</p> <p>The Parks for All project will upgrade and improve amenities for both visitors and the local communities at Wepre Country Park and Greenfield Valley, two of Flintshire's most popular heritage green spaces. Facilities will include improved toilet provision, including a Changing Places toilets and accessible play equipment.</p>	196,000
Isle of Anglesey CC	<p>Môn Coastal Gateways.</p> <p>The project will support the delivery of the Môn Coastal Gateways project which includes EV charging points, electric bike chargers, bicycle storage and improvements to infrastructure works including digital Interpretation and recycling facilities.</p>	248,000
Snowdonia NPA	<p>Improvement to Morfa Mawddach, Gwynedd</p> <p>The project will see much needed improvements to this popular site and includes car park improvements, refurbishment of the public toilet facilities, EV and bike charge points</p>	72,000
Bridgend CBC	<p>Sustainable Bridgend County Coast Path</p> <p>Funding will enable the completion of the Porthcawl Cycle Scheme which will link the cycle route from Rest Bay, to Harbourside, and the Town Centre to Trecco Bay. Smart recycle bins will also be located along the route.</p>	52,000
Monmouthshire CC	<p>Tintern Welcome</p> <p>Tintern Welcome will deliver improvements to the visitor experience at key arrival points at Tintern including the Abbey, car parks, the village centre bus stops and at the new arrival point where the Wye Valley Greenway (walking and cycling route) enters the village.</p>	250,000

Carmarthenshire CC	<p>Burry Port east car park development.</p> <p>Improvements will include accessible parking zone with disabled parking bays, additional EV points, E-bike charging facilities, 6 daytime Motorhome parking zones, smart bins, new signage and a sustainable drainage system.</p>	248,000
Neath Port Talbot CBC	<p>Margam Country Park EV Charging and Public Facilities</p> <p>The project includes EV charging infrastructure and the refurbishment of public convenience facilities at the Castle Courtyard.</p>	250,000
Pembrokeshire CC	<p>Public Convenience enhancements to improve inclusivity at Whitesands Beach.</p> <p>Redesign existing public conveniences at Whitesands Beach to include the provision of a Changing Places Toilet and Family Room. A water refill station will also be installed together with enhancements to the interior and exterior appearance of the facility to improve visitor experience.</p>	158,900
Pembrokeshire CC	<p>Tenby Beach Access Enhancements.</p> <p>Access improvements to steps, handrails and access boardwalks at North, Castle & South beaches in Tenby.</p>	42,000
Pembrokeshire Coast NPA	<p>Gwnewch y pethau bychain.</p> <p>Improved access will be seen at selected beaches in Pembrokeshire for wheelchair users that will provide a walkway across the sand, a portable changing structure with hoist and beach wheelchairs. The project will also see boardwalk access at Poppit Sands and the creation of a new viewing platform. In addition an E-bike hire pilot scheme will run in St David's.</p>	160,688
