# What is Dydd Miwsig Cymru?

Dydd Miwsig Cymru - Welsh Language Music Day - takes place on Friday 13 February 2026, and it's a celebration of the vibrant world of Welsh language music. From timeless folk traditions to cutting-edge electronica, indie anthems to hip hop beats, Welsh music reflects a living language and a thriving creative culture.

Why not join the celebrations with your school? Listening to Welsh language music is a great tool for learning both in and out of the classroom, and can be an opportunity for parents who don't speak Welsh to get closer to their child's Welsh language world in a fun and accessible way. Miwsig is for everyone.

Below are some ideas on how to get involved and how your school community can take miwsig home with them.



## How can you take part?

- **Turn up the Miwsig:** Use Spotify, YouTube or BBC Sounds (Miwsig y Siarter Iaith) to fill the school with Welsh language music all day.
- **Sing along with Seren a Sbarc Carioci:** Perfect for younger pupils, or a fun lunchtime activity.
- **Create your own Welsh language song:** Use the Creu Cân lesson plan to help pupils write, perform and celebrate their own music.
- **Host a Dydd Miwsig Cymru disco in school:** A quick lunchtime disco is an easy way to get the whole school involved.
- **Get creative with extra ideas:** Make a school playlist (staff and learner favourites), run a mini radio show, encourage local businesses to play Welsh music, or print out fun activities like wordsearches, puzzles and colouring.
