

The Social Partnership and Public Procurement (Wales) Act 2023 - Social Public Works Clauses and Social Public Workforce Clauses Exemption Notification Process: privacy notice

The Social Partnership and Public Procurement (Wales) Act 2023 (the Act) Works and Workforce Clauses Exemption Notification Process for Welsh Contracting Authorities (WCAs) will need to collect some personal information from WCAs should you ask the Welsh Ministers for an exemption to the duties placed upon your organisation by the Act. Welsh Government will be the controller for this information, and we will process it in line with our public task and the official authority vested in us.

The information WCAs provide will be used to assess your request for an exemption from the duties set out in the Act. The information collected will support the formulation of appropriate recommendations to Welsh Ministers.

Who we will share your data with

Personal data may be shared, where necessary, with Welsh Government officials and the Social Partnership Council Procurement subgroup in consideration of the exemption notification.

If information is obtained from an organisation not mentioned above, we will be able to identify and confirm the name of that organisation.

How long will we keep your data

Your personal data will be retained for a period of 3 years from the date your concern or query has been finalised.

Your rights

You have the right to request information about how your personal data are processed, and to request a copy of that personal data.

You have the right to request that any inaccuracies in your personal data are rectified without delay.

You have the right to request that any incomplete personal data are completed, including by means of a supplementary statement.

You have the right to request that your personal data are erased if there is no longer a justification for them to be processed.

You have the right in certain circumstances (for example, where accuracy is contested) to request that the processing of your personal data is restricted.

You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data where it is processed for direct marketing purposes.

You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data.

You have the right to request a copy of any personal data you have provided, and for this to be provided in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format.
