The Fair Work Commission held its third meeting on 25 October 2018.

The Commissioners talked about the progress with the Call for Evidence which would run until 19 November.

Commissioners and the Independent Expert Adviser provided updates from their areas of activity.

The group talked about current and future engagement activity in terms of business events and public sector engagement that had been arranged and which needed to be set up.

The Commission's engagement activity with various private sector and public sector representative organisations was useful as it increased awareness of events and the Call for Evidence.
