Main points

- The Emergency Assistance Payment (EAP) had 59,014 applications and the Individual Assistance Payment (IAP) had 13,062 applications during the financial year 2017 to 2018.
- 4,120 applications were approved for the IAP for people to get furniture like a sofa or freezer or a washing machine. 34,322 grants were awarded for the EAP to help pay for essential costs, such as food, gas, electricity or clothing after an emergency.
- The highest number of applications for the IAP came from people living in Cardiff (2,244), Newport (1,164) and Rhondda Cynon Taf (1,163).
- The highest number of applications for the EAP came from people living in Cardiff (9,591), Rhondda Cynon Taf (5,497) and Newport (5,279).

Emergency Assistance Payment (EAP)

A grant to help pay for essential costs, such as food, gas, electricity or clothing after an emergency.

Individual Assistance Payment (IAP)

A grant to help you or someone you care for live independently in their home or a property that you or they are moving into.
