# Diversity in the curriculum: timeline

Timeline of events for the work carried out between June 2020 and March 2021 on diversity in the curriculum.

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## 2020

### 22 June

**'BAME' Covid-19 Advisory Socio-economic sub-group report** published (sub-group to the 'BAME' COVID-19 Health Advisory Group).

### 21 July

Professor Charlotte Williams OBE appointed to lead the Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic Communities, Contributions and Cynefin in the New Curriculum Working Group.

### 19 August

First meeting of the Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic Communities, Contributions and Cynefin in the New Curriculum Working Group held.

### 1 October

Working Group's **Terms of Reference** published. See **Written Statement**

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Working Group also published its [vision statement](#) and a [prompt sheet for teachers](#) to support them to think about how their teaching reflects the multiethnic nature of Wales.

## 19 November

Working Group published its [interim report](#), focused on learning resources.

## 2021

### 9 March

Professor Williams agreed to support the delivery of the new Curriculum for Wales in an advisory and implementation role from March 2021.

### 19 March

Working Group published its [final report](#), focused on professional learning opportunities and resources (as well as a recap of the recommendations contained within the interim report on learning resources).

The previous Minister for Education announced a budget of £500,000 for 2021 to 2022 to support implementation.
