Item 1: Minutes of the previous meetings

1.1 Cymeradwyodd y Cabinet gofnodion 28 Tachwedd / Cabinet approved the minutes of 28 November.

Item 2: First Minister's items

Constitutional reports

2.1 The First Minister advised Cabinet that the report of the Commission on the UK's Future, 'A New Britain: Renewing our Democracy and Rebuilding our Economy', had been published early that day and the interim report from the Independent Commission on the Constitutional Future of Wales would be published later that week.

Item 3: Senedd Business

3.1 Cabinet considered the Plenary Grid and noted that regular voting time was scheduled for 4:20pm on Tuesday, with Stage 3 of the Environmental Protection (Single-use Plastics Products) (Wales) Bill commencing around 4:35pm. Voting time would be around 6:10pm on Wednesday.

Item 4: Draft Budget Package

- 4.1 The Minister for Finance and Local Government introduced the paper, which asked Cabinet to agree the MEG level allocations for the 2023-24 Draft Budget, ahead of publication on 13th December.
- 4.2 Ministers were aware of the challenges posed by the budget and the implications of the financial restrictions.
- 4.3 Despite this, it had been possible to deliver a budget that seeks to balance short and long-term outcomes alongside prioritising support for those in need

despite the economic situation.

- 4.4 The paper provided details of changes and reflected the work to finalise the revenue allocations for 2023-24 and indicative spending plans for 2024-25.
- 4.5 Cabinet approved the paper.
