- 3.1 The Minister for Finance and Local Government introduced the paper, which asked Cabinet to note the outcome of the phase 1 consultation on proposals to reform council tax, in line with the Programme for Government commitment for a fairer and more progressive tax in Wales. It was also part of the Co-operation Agreement with Plaid Cymru.
- 3.2 The aim was to publish the consultation responses on 16 December.
