<b>Sale/Transfer of land under contract</b>			
<b>Welsh Government must be informed within 30 days of any sale or transfer of land in a Glastir Contract.</b>			
<b>Breach</b>	<b>Severity</b>	<b>Extent</b>	<b>Duration</b>
Contract requires sales and transfers to be notified within 30 days.	<b>Low</b> - Notification received, but not within 21 days.	<b>Extent 1</b>	<b>Rectifiable 1</b>
