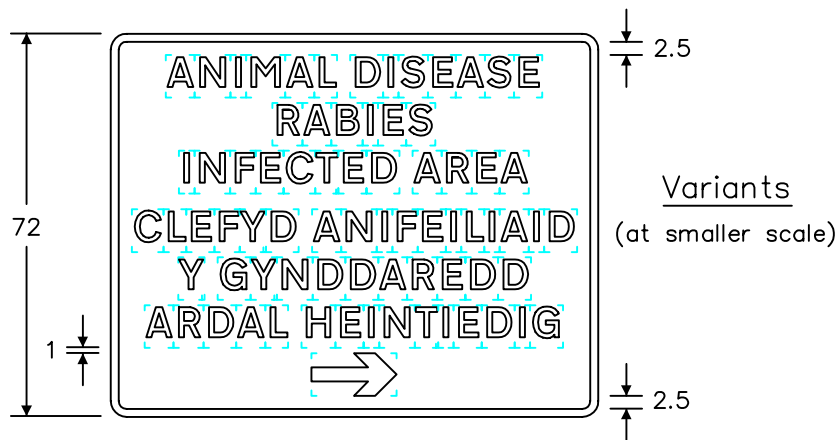


Notes:-

1. The legend is from the Transport Medium alphabet at the 'x'-heights shown.
2. The outlines of the tiles do not form part of the sign.
3. The colours are as follows:-
Background ——— Red
Legend, border ——— White
and arrow
4. The illumination of the sign must accord with the requirements of the current 'Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions'.
5. The 'x'-heights shown are given in millimetres, all other dimensions are given in stroke widths (i.e. $1s/w = 1/4 \times \text{'x'-height}$).
6. The sign is designed in accordance with the current design rules.
7. The order of languages may be reversed if required.
8. Variants:-
1. 'RABIES' ('Y GYNDDAREDD') may be omitted or varied to any appropriate animal disease, on one or two lines.
2. 'AHEAD' ('O'CH BLAEN') may be omitted or varied to a horizontal arrow pointing left or right.
3. 'INFECTED AREA AHEAD' ('ARDAL HEINTIEDIG O'CH BLAEN') may be varied to 'INFECTED AREA ENDS' ('DIWEDD YR ARDAL HEINTIEDIG')
