
Notes: -

- 1. The lettering is from the Transport Medium alphabet at 250 mm 'x'-ht. (350mm upper case height) Schedule 13 Part VI to the Regulations.
- 2. The lettering and markings shall be white.
- 3. The areas dimensioned show how the vehicle space is determined regardless of the angle at which the boundary marks are laid.
- 4. Disabled parking areas may be placed where most convenient.
- The projected lines on either side of the words 'DISABLED' ('ANABL') show the area reserved for these drivers. Where more than one area is reserved the words may be centralised or repeated. The words 'DOCTOR' ('MEDDYG') and/or CAR CLUB ('CLWB CEIR') may be added.
- 6. The order of languages may be reversed if required.
- 7. All dimension are given in millimetres.
