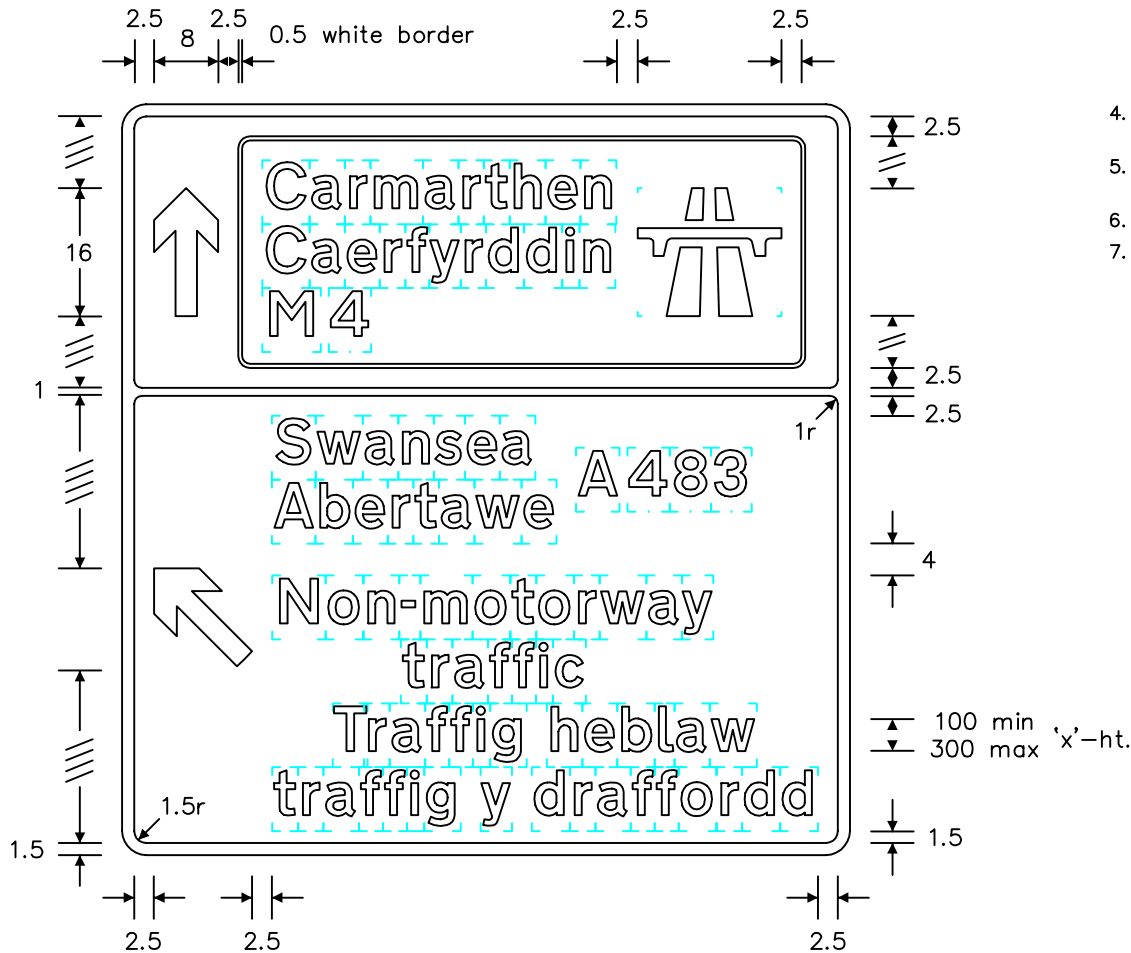


Notes: -
