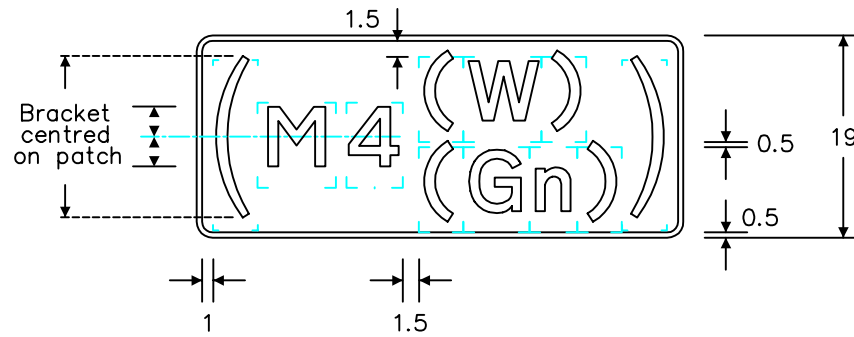
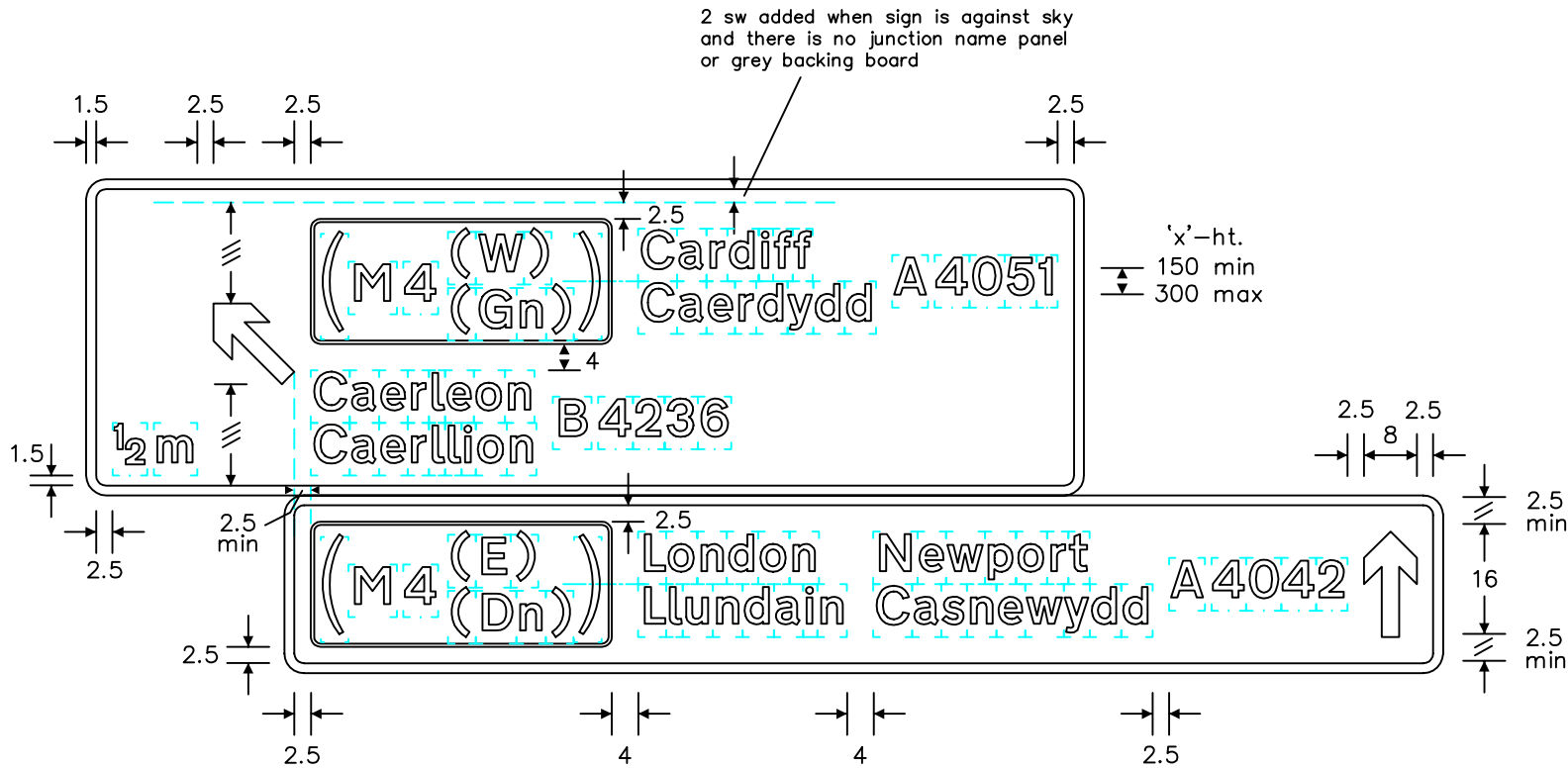


Notes: -
