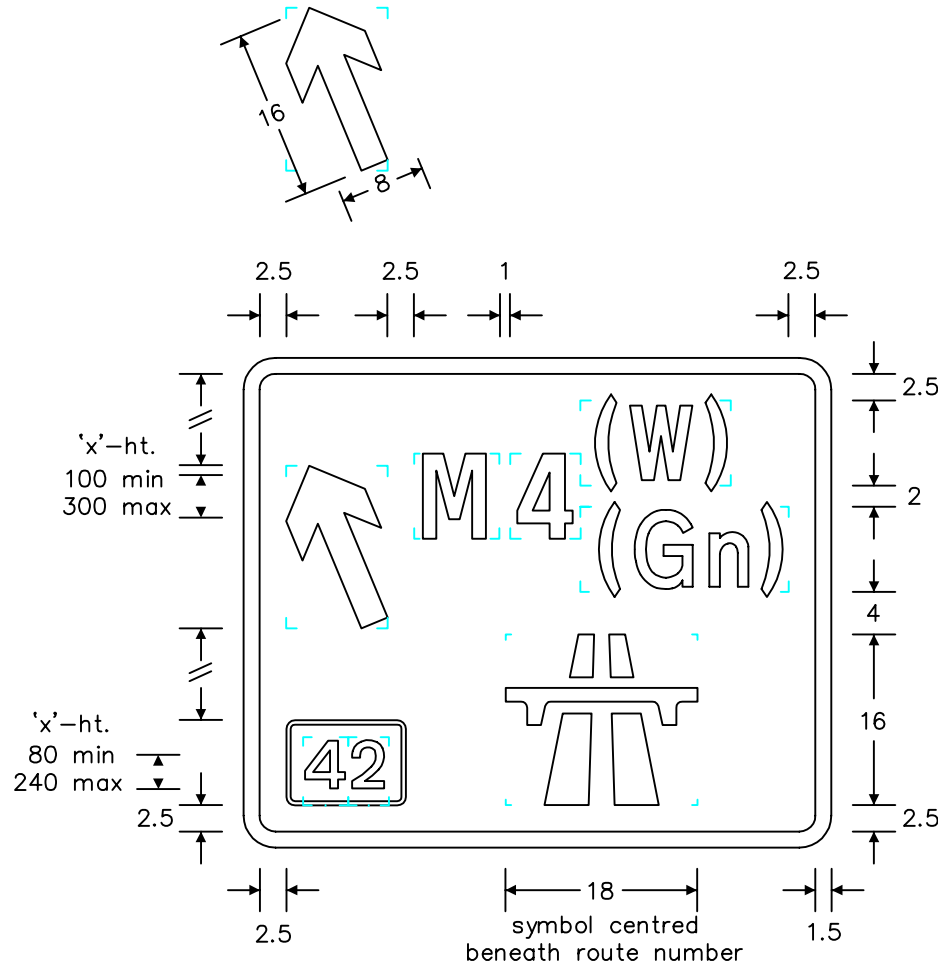


Notes: -

6. The 'x'-heights shown are given in millimetres, all other dimensions are given in stroke widths (i.e. $1s/w = 1/4x'$ -height).
7. The sign is designed in accordance with the current design rules.
