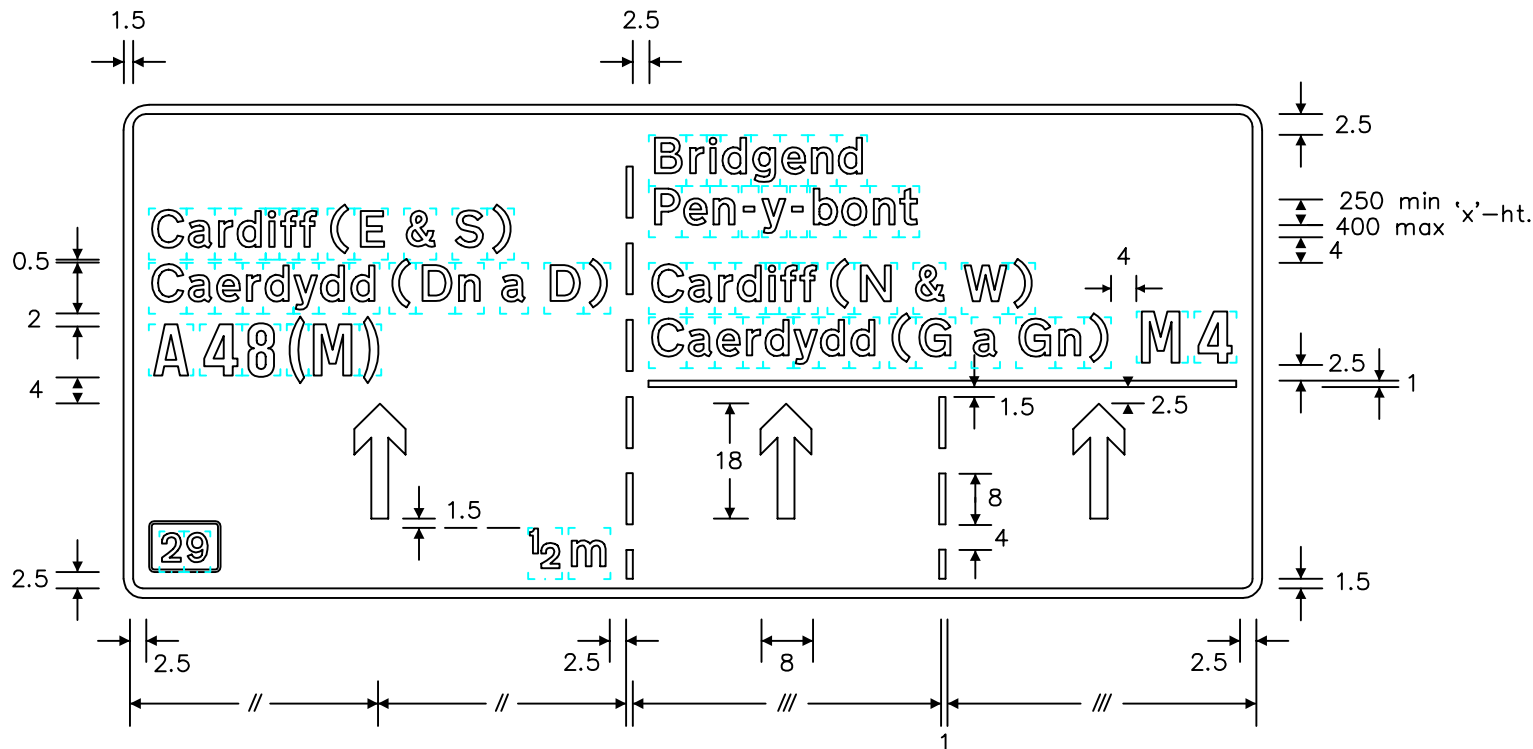


These dimensions are in stroke widths based on the 'x'-height of the junction number which is 80% of the main 'x'-height.

Notes:-
