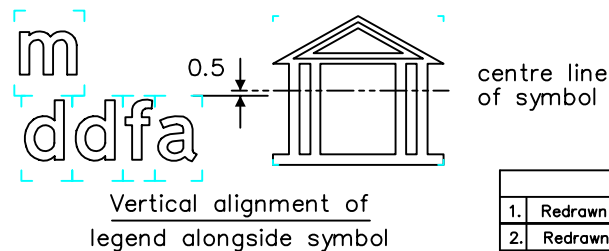


Notes:-

1. The legend is from the Transport Medium alphabet at the 'x'- heights shown.
2. Details of the symbols are given on the T series of drawings.
3. The outlines of the tiles do not form part of the sign.
4. The colours are as follows:-  
 Legend, symbols, \_\_\_\_\_ White  
 arrow & border \_\_\_\_\_ Brown  
 Background \_\_\_\_\_ Brown
5. The illumination of the sign must accord with the requirements of the current 'Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions'.
6. The 'x'-heights shown are given in millimetres, all other dimensions are given in stroke widths (i.e.  $1s/w = 1/4 \times \text{'x'-height}$ ).
7. The sign is designed in accordance with the current design rules.
8. The order of languages may be reversed if required.
9. Symbols for picnic area, youth hostel, caravan park, camping site, light refreshment facilities, restaurant and hotel or other overnight accommodation SHALL NOT be used on a motorway.
