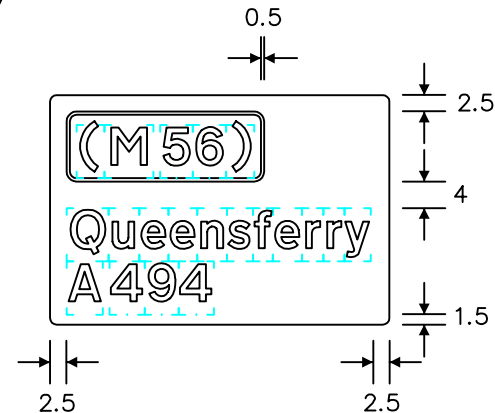
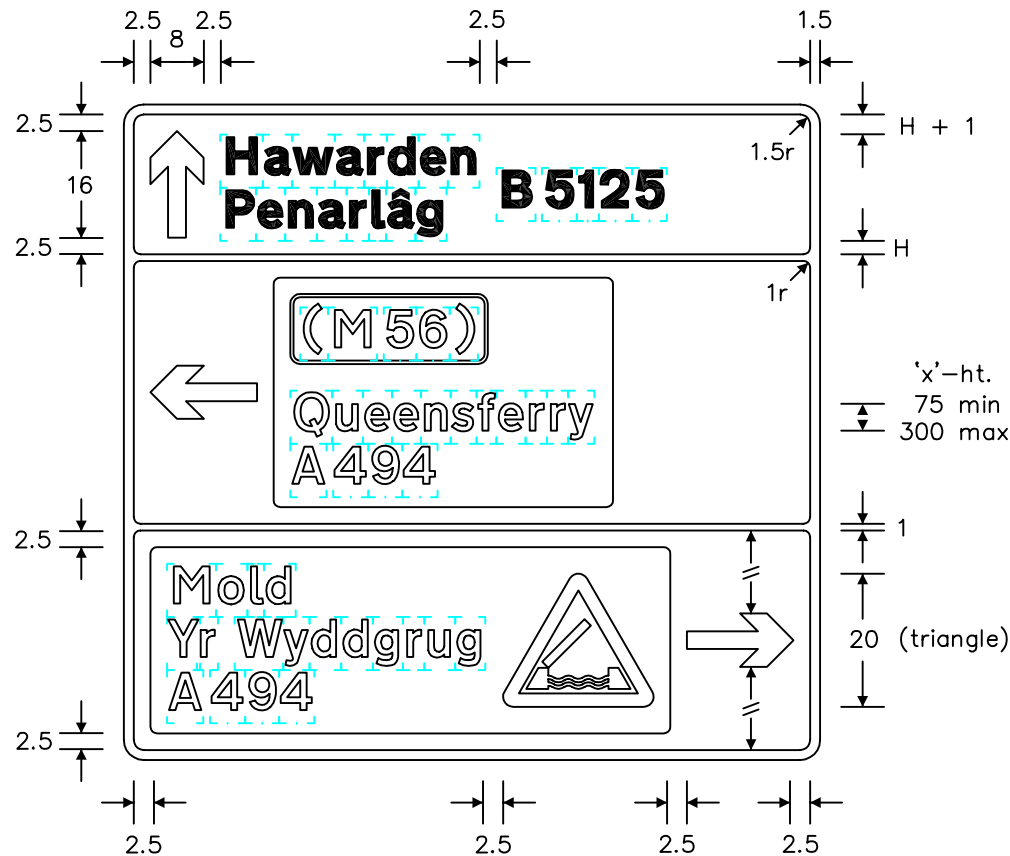


Notes: -

- The legends are from the Transport Heavy and Transport Medium alphabets at the 'x'-heights shown.
- The outlines of the tiles do not form part of the sign.
- Details of the 'Lifting bridge' triangle are given on P529.
- The colours are as follows: -
  - Main Sign: -
    - Background \_\_\_\_\_ White
    - Border, panel dividers & arrows \_\_\_\_\_ Black
    - Legend \_\_\_\_\_ Black (Transport Heavy)
  - Primary route panels: -
    - Background \_\_\_\_\_ Green
    - Legend \_\_\_\_\_ White (Transport Medium)
    - Route number \_\_\_\_\_ Yellow (Transport Medium)
  - Motorway patch: -
    - Background \_\_\_\_\_ Blue
    - Legend \_\_\_\_\_ White (Transport Medium)
- The illumination of the sign must accord with the requirements of the current 'Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions'.
- The 'x'-heights shown are given in millimetres, all other dimensions are given in stroke widths (i.e.  $1s/w = 1/4 \times \text{'x'-height}$ ).
- The sign is designed in accordance with the current design rules.
- The order of languages may be reversed if required.
