 Background \_\_\_\_\_ Blue  
 Symbol \_\_\_\_\_ White  
 Legend \_\_\_\_\_ White (Transport Medium)  
 Junction no. patch: -  
 Background \_\_\_\_\_ Black  
 Border & number \_\_\_\_\_ White
