





- 1. The legend is from the Transport Medium alphabet at the 'x'—heights shown.
- 2. Details of the lorry symbol are given on drawing S 32 sheet 1. The symbol faces the direction of the arrow.
- 3. The outlines of the tiles do not form part of the sign.




- 5. The illumination of the sign must accord with the requirements of the current 'Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions'.
- 6. The 'x'-heights shown are given in millimetres, all other dimensions are given in stroke widths based on the 60min/300max 'x'-ht (i.e. 1s/w = 1/4'x'-height).
- 7. The sign is designed in accordance with the current design rules.
- 8. The order of languages may be reversed if required.
- 9. See sheet 1 for other dimensions and for other variants. The alternative route message has an 'x'-height of 80% of the main sign 'x'-height.
