
- 1. The legend is from the Transport Heavy alphabet at the 'x'-heights shown.
- 2. Details of the 'WC' and 'Wheelchair' symbols are given on drwgs S 44 and S 45.
- 3. The outlines of the tiles do not form part of the sign.
- 4. The colours are as follows: -

Wheelchair symbol ----


Background — White Border, legend, chevron & 'WC' symbol — Black

— White on Black tile

- 5. The illumination of the sign must accord with the requirements of the current 'Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions'.
- 6. The 'x'-heights shown are given in millimetres, all other dimensions are given in stroke widths based on the main legend (i.e. 1s/w = 1/4'x'-height).
- 7. The sign is designed in accordance with the current design rules.
- 8. The order of languages may be reversed if required.
