

Changes to the Data Protection Act

From 25 May the new General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) will come in force, this will replace the current Data Protection Act.

Currently your contact details are stored within an excel spreadsheet which is only accessible by secretariats of stakeholder groups. The information held is used to:

- Inform stakeholders of meetings
- Inform stakeholders of consultations and outcomes
- Inform stakeholders of information relevant to their particular interest

All emails sent are covered by the BCC option of an email, this means that third parties are unable to see your details, neither is the information we hold passed on to third parties without your prior consent.

At this stage members are not required to take any action, however, to ensure Welsh Government remain compliant with the new regulations, members of WMFAG and all stakeholders are being encouraged to register their details on the Welsh Government Stakeholder database.
