GDPR and gov.wales/llyw.cymru

- 1. Via BC, SM informed the committee that ICANN and Nominet are consulting on change to the use of registrant data due to GDPR.
- 2. With regards to GDPR and personal data, AC informed the committee that applications for .gov.wales and llyw.cymru are usually only made by organisations. Potentially you could have a small community organisation where the clerk's office is at home, with their details being supplied rather than the office of the organisation. AC suggested the best approach would be to contact these people directly to ask if they wish their details to be removed.
- 3. The committee agreed to keep monitoring the Nominet consultation with regards to .cymru and .wales.

Committee membership

4. SM informed the committee of the retirement of Del Morgan from his role at One Voice Wales and therefore ceasing his position on the WNAC committee. SM has been in touch with Once Voice Wales to see if they would like to nominate a replacement for Del on the committee.

Outstanding issues

- 5. BC confirmed that the only current issue outstanding (since the previous chair of the WNAC left their post). Domains that were set up as council domains, but controlled by Welsh Government, this meant they were being regarded as Welsh Government owned. Therefore creating a series of problems about Whois, Certificates, Ownership, visibility etc.
- 6. Action: SM to investigate further with required information from BC.

- 7. **Action:** SM to provide BC with an electronic version of the Memorandum of Agreement between the Welsh Government and JISC
- 8. AD asked BC if changes could be made to the email template that is sent out on domain acceptance. AD explained that applicants should be aware that an email should be set up on the domains they have applied for.
