The A470 Trunk Road (Northbound Link Road at Coryton Interchange, Cardiff) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2015

Made 11 June 2015

Coming into force 15 June 2015

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the Cardiff – Llangurig Trunk Road (A470) ("the trunk road"), in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 84 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and after consultation with the Chief Officer of the South Wales Police, make this Order.

Title and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 15 June 2015 and its title is The A470 Trunk Road (Northbound Link Road at Coryton Interchange, Cardiff) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2015.

Restriction

2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road which forms the dedicated A470 northbound link road at Coryton Interchange in the City and County of Cardiff that extends from its junction with the main circulatory carriageway of Coryton Interchange to its junction with the main southbound carriageway of the A470.

THE A470 TRUNK ROAD (NORTHBOUND LINK ROAD AT CORYTON INTERCHANGE, CARDIFF) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2015

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order under section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which comes in to force on 15 June 2015.

The effect of the Order is to impose a 40 mph speed limit on the length of the A470 trunk road which forms the dedicated northbound link road at Coryton Interchange in the City and County of Cardiff from its junction with the main circulatory carriageway of Coryton Interchange to its junction with the main southbound carriageway of the A470.
