#### The Brynhenllys Revised (Suspension of Public Rights Of Way) (Revocation) Order 2014

*Made* 28 April 2014

*Coming into force* 29 April 2014

The Welsh Ministers make this Order in exercise of the power conferred by section 15 of the Opencast Coal Act 1958(1) (“the Act”) and now vested in them(2).

For the purposes of section 15 of the Act, the Welsh Ministers consider that the condition in section 15(4)(b) is satisfied.

#### **Title, commencement and extent**

1.—(1) The title of this Order is the The Brynhenllys Revised (Suspension of Public Rights of Way) (Revocation) Order 2014.

(2) This Order comes into force on 29 April 2014.

(3) It applies in relation to Wales.

#### **Revocation**

2. The Brynhenllys Revised, (Suspension of Public Rights of Way) Order 1993 is revoked.
