**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order is made under section 2 of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937 (as substituted by the Diseases of Fish Act 1983).

In this Order the inland waters and land within the area referred to in the Schedule to the Order are designated for the purposes of section 2 of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937.

This Order prohibits the moving of any live fish or live fish eggs into or out of the designated area without the previous consent in writing of the National Assembly for Wales.

The National Assembly for Wales, having reasonable grounds for suspecting that certain inland waters are, or may become, infected waters and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(1) and (2) of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937(1), makes the following Order—

**Title and commencement**

1. The title of this Order is the Diseases of Fish (Designated Area) (Wales) Order 2006 and it comes into force on 13 June 2006.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Order:—

“designated area” means the area designated by article 3 of this Order.

**Designated Areas**

3. The inland waters and land within the area referred to in the Schedule to this Order are designated for the purpose of section 2 of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937.

(1) 1937 c.33. Section 2 of the 1937 Act was replaced by the Diseases of Fish Act 1983 (c.30), section 2. The functions of the Minister under section 2 of the 1937 Act were transferred to the National Assembly for Wales by article 2 of and Schedule 1 to the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999 (S.I. 1999/672).

#### **Controls in relation to Designated Areas**

4. No person is permitted without the previous consent in writing of the National Assembly for Wales to take into or out of the designated area any—

- (1) live fish; or
- (2) live eggs of fish.
