NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE ACT 1977

DIRECTIONS TO LOCAL HEALTH BOARDS AND NHS TRUSTS IN WALES 2006

Made	3 April 2006
Coming into force	3 April 2006

The National Assembly for Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 16BB(4), 17(1), 97F(8) and 126(4) of the National Health Service Act 1977(1) hereby gives the following directions —

Commencement, application and interpretation

1.—(1) These Directions come into force on 3 April 2006 and apply to every Local Health Board and NHS trust in Wales.

- (2) These Directions apply in relation to Wales.
- (3) In these Directions —

"the Principal Directions" ("*y Prif Gyfarwyddiadau*") means the Directions to Local Health Boards and NHS trusts in Wales concerning Arrangements for the Funding of Technology Appraisal Guidance from the National Institute for Clinical Excellence (NICE) dated 23 October 2003(2).

(4) These Directions amend the Principal Directions.

Amendment of paragraph 3 of the Principal Directions

2.—(1) In paragraph 3(2) of the Principal Directions (Exempt Technology Appraisal Guidance) delete sub-paragraph (c).

(2) In paragraph 3 of the Principal Directions (Exempt Technology Appraisal Guidance) at the end of paragraph 3(1)(A) insert as paragraph 3(1)(B) the following —

"(1)(B) In respect of the Technology Appraisal Guidance (No. 60) on the use of patient-education models for diabetes dated 2 May 2003, paragraph 2 of these Directions applies except that the words "a date not later than three months from the date of that Technology Appraisal Guidance" will be replaced by the words "3 April 2006"."
