DIRECTIONS TO LOCAL HEALTH BOARDS AND NHS TRUSTS IN WALES 2009

Made 19 March 2009

Coming into force 20 March 2009

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 12(3), 19(1), 174(10) and 203(9) of the National Health Service (Wales) Act 2006(1) hereby give the following directions—

Commencement, application and interpretation

- **1.**—(1) These Directions come into force on 20 March 2009 and apply to every Local Health Board and NHS trust in Wales.
 - (2) These Directions apply in relation to Wales.
 - (3) In these Directions
 - "the Principal Directions" ("y Prif Gyfarwyddiadau") means the Directions to Local Health Boards and NHS trusts in Wales concerning Arrangements for the Funding of Technology Appraisal Guidance from the National Institute for Clinical Excellence (NICE) dated 23 October 2003(2).
 - (4) These Directions amend the Principal Directions.

Amendment of direction 3 of the Principal Directions

2.—(1) In direction 3 of the Principal Directions (Exempt Technology Appraisal Guidance), after subparagraph (1)(g), insert the following sub-paragraph —
