**National Health Service (Wales) Act 2006**

The Directions to Local Health Boards as to the Personal Dental Services Statement of Financial Entitlements (Amendment) Directions 2010

*Made* 17 June 2010

*Coming into force* 17 June 2010

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 66(4) and (5), 203(9) and (10), and 204(1) of the National Health Service (Wales) Act 2006<sup>(1)</sup> give the following directions.

**Title and commencement**

1.—(1) The title of these Directions is the Directions to Local Health Boards as to the Personal Dental Services Statement of Financial Entitlements (Amendment) Directions 2010.

(2) These Directions come into force on 17 June 2010 and have effect from 1 April 2010.

**Amendments to the Personal Dental Services Statement of Financial Entitlements**

2.—(1) The directions given by the Welsh Ministers in the Directions given to Local Health Boards as to the Personal Dental Services Statement of Financial Entitlements <sup>(2)</sup>, which came into force on 24 April 2009 are amended as follows.

## **Amendment of Section 2**

**3.** In Section 2 (Negotiated Annual Agreement Values), for paragraph 2.10 substitute “The percentage determined by the Welsh Ministers for the financial year commencing on 1 April 2010 is 0.9%.”

## **Amendment of Section 7**

**4.—(1)** Section 7 (Payments in respect of vocational training), is amended as follows—

- (a) in paragraph 7.2(c) (Eligibility for payments in respect of vocational training), for “£2, 634.95” substitute “£2,511”;
- (b) in paragraph 7.4(c) (Applications for payments under this Section), for “2,634.95” substitute “£2,511”; and
- (c) in paragraph 7.5 (Vocational training payments to be made)—
  - (i) in sub-paragraph (b), for “£2,634.95” substitute “£2,511”; and
  - (ii) in sub-paragraph (d), for “4,859.34” substitute “4,903.07”.

(2) The amendments set out in paragraph (1) do not apply in relation to vocational trainees who commenced their training courses on or before 31 March 2010.
