**The Directions to Local Health Boards as to the Personal Dental
Services Statement of Financial Entitlements (Amendment)
Directions 2017**

The Welsh Ministers in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 66(4) and (5), 203(9) and (10), and 204(1) of the National Health Service (Wales) Act 2006⁽¹⁾, give the following Directions:

Title and commencement

1.—(1) The title of these Directions is the Directions to Local Health Boards as to the Personal Dental Services Statement of Financial Entitlements (Amendment) Directions 2017.

(2) These Directions come into force on 4 May 2017 but have effect from 1 April 2017.

Amendments to the Personal Dental Services Statement of Financial Entitlements

2. The Directions given by the Welsh Ministers to Local Health Boards as to the Personal Dental Services Statement of Financial Entitlements⁽²⁾, which came into force on 24 April 2009 are amended as follows.

Amendment of Section 2

3. In section 2 (negotiated annual agreement values) for paragraph 2.10 substitute:—

“2.10 The percentage determined by the Welsh Ministers for the financial year commencing on 1 April 2017 is 1.44%”.

Amendment of Section 7

4.—(1) Section 7 (payments in respect of vocational training), is amended as follows—


(a) in paragraph 7.2(c) (eligibility for payments in respect of vocational training), for “£2,561”, substitute “£2,587”;

- (b) in paragraph 7.4(c) (applications for payments under this section), for “£2,561”, substitute “£2,587”; and
- (c) in paragraph 7.5 (vocational training payments to be made)—
 - (i) in sub-paragraph (b), for “£2,561”, substitute “£2,587”; and
 - (ii) in sub-paragraph (d), for “£5,024”, substitute “£5,096”.
