Directions to NHS Bodies on
Counter Fraud Measures (Wales)
(Amendment) (No 2) Directions
2006

Made 16 October 2006

Coming into force 17 October 2006

The National Assembly for Wales acting in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 16BB(4), 17 and 126(4) of the National Health Service Act 1977(1), hereby gives the following Directions:

Commencement, interpretation and application

1.—(1) These Directions come into force on 17 October 2006 and are given to the NHS bodies in Wales.

(2) These Directions apply in relation to Wales.

(3) In these Directions —

(1) 1977 c.49. Section 16BB(4) was inserted by the National Health Service Reform and Health Care Professions Act 2002 (c.17) and was amended by section 184 of and paragraphs 7 and 10 of Schedule 11 to the Health and Social Care (Community Health and Standards Act 2003 (c.43). Section 17 was substituted by section 12(1) of the Health Act 1999 (c.8) (“the 1999 Act”) and was amended by section 67(1) of and Schedule 5, Part 1, paragraph 5(1) and (3), to the Health and Social Care Act 2001 (c.15). The functions of the Secretary of State under sections 17 (except in some cases not relevant to these directions), and 126(4) are, so far as exercisable in relation to Wales, transferred to the National Assembly for Wales by article 2(a) of the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999, S.I. 1999/672 as amended by section 66(4) and (5) of the 1999 Act.

“the 2005 Directions” means the Directions to NHS Bodies on Counter Fraud Measures 2005(1); and

“the 2006 Directions” means the Directions to NHS Bodies on Counter Fraud Measures (Wales) (Amendment) Directions 2006.

Amendment of the 2005 Directions

2.The 2005 Directions are amended as follows.

3. In direction 3(5) the reference to direction 8(f) is amended to direction 7(f).

4.In direction 6(2) the reference to the Counter Fraud and Security Management Service Division of the NHS BSA is amended to LCFS(2).

5.In direction 7(1)(a) the reference to direction 7(1) is amended to direction 6(1).

Amendment of the 2006 Directions

6.The 2006 Directions are amended as follows.

7.In direction 5 the words and letters “6 (Responsibilities and functions of the Local Counter Fraud Specialist)” are removed.
