Yn dod i rym 17 Medi 2018

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru, sef yr awdurdod traffig ar gyfer Cefnffordd yr A5, wedi eu bodloni y dylid cyfyngu ar draffig a/neu ei wahardd ar ddarn penodedig o'r gefnffordd oherwydd gwaith y bwriedir ei wneud ar y ffordd neu gerllaw iddi.

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru, felly, drwy arfer y pwerau a roddir iddynt gan adran 14(1), (4) a (7) o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrd 1984(1), yn gwneud y Gorchymyn hwn.

Enwi, Cychwyn a Dehongli

1. Enw'r Gorchymyn hwn yw Gorchymyn Cefnffordd yr A5 (Man i'r Gogledd o Fethesda i Lys y Gwynt, Bangor, Gwynedd) (Cyfyngiadau Cyflymder Dros Dro a Dim Goddiwedd) 2018 a daw i rym ar 17 Medi 2018.

2. Yn y Gorchymyn hwn:

ystyr "cerbyd esempt" ("exempted vehicle") yw:

- (a) unrhyw gerbyd sy'n cael ei ddefnyddio at y dibenion a ddisgrifir yn adran 87 o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrd 1984(2); a

(1) 1984 p.27; amnewidiwyd adran 14 gan adran 1(1) o Ddeddf Traffig Ffyrd (Cyfyngiadau Dros Dro) 1991 (p.26) ac Atodlen 1 iddi. Yn rhinwedd O.S. 1999/672, ac adran 162 o Ddeddf Llywodraeth Cymru 2006 (p.32) a pharagraff 30 o Atodlen 11 iddi, mae'r pwerau hyn yn arferadwy bellach gan Weinidogion Cymru o ran Cymru.

(2) Diwygiwyd adran 87 gan baragraff 55 o Atodlen 1 i Ddeddf Gwasanaethau Tân ac Achub 2004 (p.21), paragraff 42 o Atodlen 4 i Ddeddf Trosedd Cyfundrefnol Difrifol a'r Heddlu 2005 (p.15), paragraff 29(2) o Atodlen 8 i Ddeddf Trosedd a'r Llysoedd 2013 (p.22) ac adran 50(4) a (5) o Ddeddf Dadreoleiddio 2015 (p.20).

ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A5 Trunk Road (North of Bethesda to Llys y Gwynt, Bangor, Gwynedd) (Temporary Speed Restrictions & No Overtaking) Order 2018

Made 12 September 2018

Coming into force 17 September 2018

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited and/or restricted because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1), (4) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A5 Trunk Road (North of Bethesda to Llys y Gwynt, Bangor, Gwynedd) (Temporary Speed Restrictions & No Overtaking) Order 2018 and it comes into force on 17 September 2018.

2. In this Order:

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means:

- (a) any vehicle being used for the purposes described in section 87 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(2); and

(1) 1984 c.27; section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1. By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c.32), these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

(2) Section 87 was amended by the Fire and Rescue Services Act 2004 (c.21), Schedule 1, paragraph 55, the Serious Organised Crime and Police Act 2005 (c.15), Schedule 4, paragraph 42, the Crime and Courts Act 2013 (c.22), Schedule 8, paragraph 29(2) and the Deregulation Act 2015 (c.20), section 50(4) and (5).

(b) unrhyw gerbyd sy'n cael ei ddefnyddio at ddibenion y llynges, y fyddin neu'r llu awyr ac sy'n cael ei yrru gan berson sydd am y tro yn ddarostyngedig i orchymion aelod o luoedd arfog y Goron, sy'n aelod o'r luoedd arbennig—

- (i) ac sydd wedi ei hyfforddi i yrru ar gyflymderau uchel ac sy'n gweithredu wrth ymateb, neu wrth ymarfer ymateb, i argywng diogelwch gwladol; neu
- (ii) at ddiben hyfforddi person i yrru cerbydau ar gyflymderau uchel;

ystyr “cyfnod y gwaith” (“works period”) yw'r cyfnod hwnnw sy'n dechrau am 07:00 o'r gloch ar 17 Medi 2018 ac sy'n dod i ben pan gaiff yr arwyddion traffig dros dro eu symud ymaith yn barhaol;

ystyr “y gefnffordd” (“the trunk road”) yw Cefnffordd yr A5 Llundain i Gaergybi yn Sir Gwynedd sy'n ymestyn o bwynt 100 metr i'r gogledd o'i chyffordd â'r ffordd sirol sy'n arwain at Rachub hyd at ei chyffordd â Chylchfan Llys y Gwynt, Bangor;

ystyr “luoedd arbennig” (“special forces”) yw'r unedau hynny o'r luoedd arfog y mae Cyfarwyddwr y Lluoedd Arbennig yn gyfrifol am gynnal eu galluoedd neu sydd am y tro yn ddarostyngedig i reolaeth weithredol y Cyfarwyddwr hwnnw.

Cyfyngiadau a Gwaharddiad

3. Ni chaiff neb, yn ystod cyfnod y gwaith, yrru unrhyw gerbyd modur yn gyflymach na 40 milltir yr awr ar y darn o'r gefnffordd.

4. Ni chaiff neb, yn ystod cyfnod y gwaith, yrru unrhyw gerbyd modur yn gyflymach na 10 milltir yr awr ar y darn o'r gefnffordd.

5. Ni chaiff neb, yn ystod cyfnod y gwaith, ddefnyddio cerbyd na chaniatáu i gerbyd, ac eithrio cerbyd esempt, gael ei ddefnyddio yn y fath fodd fel ei fod yn goddiwedd yd unrhyw gerbyd arall ar y darn o'r gefnffordd ar yr adegau hynny pan fo'r cyfyngiad y cyfeirir ato yn erthygl 4 yn weithredol.

Cymhwysyo

6.—(1) Ni fydd y cyfyngiadau a'r gwaharddiad yn erthyglau 3, 4 a 5 yn gymwys ond ar yr adegau hynny ac i'r graddau hynny y bydd arwyddion traffig yn eu dangos.

(2) Nid yw unrhyw derfynau cyflymder a osodir gan y Gorchymyn hwn yn gymwys i gerbyd esempt.

Atal Dros Dro

7. Mae unrhyw ddarpariaethau statudol sy'n cyfyngu

(b) any vehicle being used for naval, military or air force purposes and being driven by a person for the time being subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown, who is a member of the special forces—

- (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving at high speeds; or
- (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds;

“special forces” (“luoedd arbennig”) means those units of the armed forces the maintenance of whose capabilities is the responsibility of the Director of Special Forces or which are for the time being subject to the operational command of that Director;

“the trunk road” (“y gefnffordd”) means the A5 London to Holyhead Trunk Road in the County of Gwynedd that extends from a point 100 metres north of its junction with the county road leading to Rachub to its junction with Llys y Gwynt Roundabout, Bangor;

“works period” (“cyfnod y gwaith”) means that period commencing at 07:00 hours on 17 September 2018 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Restrictions and Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of the trunk road.

4. No person may, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the length of the trunk road.

5. No person may, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle on the length of the trunk road during such times as the restriction referred to in article 4 is in operation.

Application

6.—(1) The restrictions and prohibition in articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

(2) No speed limits imposed by this Order apply to an exempted vehicle.

Suspensions

7. Any statutory provisions restricting the speed of motor vehicles on the length of the trunk road are suspended during such times as the restrictions

GORCHYMYN CEFNFFORDD YR A5 (MAN I'R GOGLEDD O FETHESDA I LYS Y GWYNT, BANGOR, GWYNEDD) (CYFNGIADAU CYFLYMDER DROS DRO A DIM GODDIWEDDYD) 2018

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru wedi gwneud Gorchymyn o dan adrann 14 o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984. Mae angen y Gorchymyn am fod gwaith yn cael ei wneud ar gefnffordd yr A5, neu gerllaw iddi, rhwng Bethesda a Bangor, Gwynedd.

Effaith y Gorchymyn yw gosod terfyn cyflymder o naill ai 40 mya neu 10 mya dros dro ar y darn o gefnffordd yr A5 sy'n ymestyn o bwynt 100 metr i'r gogledd o'i chyffordd â'r ffordd sirol sy'n arwain at Rachub hyd at ei chyffordd â Chylchfan Llys y Gwynt, Bangor. Dim ond yn ystod gwaith confoi y bydd y terfyn cyflymder o 10 mya yn gymwys ac ni chaniateir goddiwedd yd ar yr adegau hyn.

Disgwylir y bydd y cyfyngiadau a'r gwaharddiad, y codir arwyddion priodol yn eu cylch, yn dod i rym am 07:00 o'r gloch ar 17 Medi 2018 ac yn weithredol tan 23:59 o'r gloch ar 29 Medi 2018 neu hyd nes y caiff yr arwyddion traffig dros dro eu symud ymaith yn barhaol.

Dim ond yn ystod y cyfnod a bennir uchod y disgwylir i'r Gorchymyn fod yn weithredol. Er hynny, bydd yn parhau'n ddilys am gyfnod o 18 mis ar y mwyaf rhag ofn y bydd angen ailamserlennu'r gwaith neu wneud gwaith canlyniadol neu waith arall. Bydd hysbysiad ymlaen llaw am unrhyw newidiadau i'r amseroedd a'r dyddiadau yn cael ei arddangos cyn unrhyw waith a ailamserlennir.

THE A5 TRUNK ROAD (NORTH OF BETHESDA TO LLYS Y GWYNT, BANGOR, GWYNEDD) (TEMPORARY SPEED RESTRICTIONS & NO OVERTAKING) ORDER 2018

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which is necessary to undertake works on or near the A5 trunk road between Bethesda and Bangor, Gwynedd.

The effect of the Order is to temporarily impose either a 40 mph or 10 mph speed limit on the length of the A5 trunk road that extends from a point 100 metres north of its junction with the county road leading to Rachub to its junction with Llys y Gwynt Roundabout, Bangor. The 10 mph speed limit will only apply during convoy working and no overtaking will be permitted during these times.

The restrictions and prohibition, which will be signed accordingly, are expected to come into force at 07:00 hours on 17 September 2018 and operate until 23:59 hours on 29 September 2018 or until the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Although the Order is only expected to operate during the period specified above it will remain valid for a maximum period of 18 months, as a contingency, should the work need to be rescheduled or consequential or other work is required. Advance notice of any changes to times and dates will be displayed before any rescheduled work.
