EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

The YMCA Wales Community College Limited is designated by this Order for the purposes of section 28 of the Further and Higher Education Act 1992. This means that it is to be treated as an institution within the further education sector for the purposes of the Education Acts.

Article 3 revokes the designation made in the Education (Designated Institutions in Further Education) (Wales) Order 1993 (No. 215), to the National Council of Young Men's Christian Associations of Wales.

The YMCA Wales Community College (Designated Institutions in Further Education) (Wales) Order 2007

Made 25 April 2007

Coming into force 1 August 2007

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Secretary of State by sections 28 and 89(1) of the Further and Higher Education Act 1992(1), and now vested in the National Assembly for Wales(2), the National Assembly for Wales hereby makes the following Order.

- **1.** This Order is called the YMCA Wales Community College (Designated Institutions in Further Education) (Wales) Order 2007 and comes into force on 1 August 2007.
- 2.—(1) The YMCA Wales Community College Limited, being an educational institution of the kind described in sub-sections (1) and (2) of section 28 of the Further and Higher Education Act 1992, is hereby designated as an institution for the purposes of that section.
- **3.**—(1) The Education (Designated Institutions in Further Education) (Wales) Order 1993(3) is amended as follows: -
- (2) In Schedule 1, omit "National Council of Young Men's Christian Associations of Wales".
