(Amendment) Directions 2014**

Made 10 March 2014

Coming into force 1st April 2014

The Welsh Ministers give the following Directions in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 12(1)(b) and (3), 13(2)(c), (3)(c) and (4)(c) and 203(9) and 204(1) of the National Health Service (Wales) Act 2006(1).

Title, commencement and application

1.—(1) The title of these Directions is the Welsh Health Specialised Services Committee (Wales) (Amendment) Directions 2014.

(2) These Directions come into force on 1 April 2014.

(3) These Directions are given to Local Health Boards and apply in relation to Wales.

Interpretation

2. In these Directions, “the principal Directions” (“*y prif Gyfarwyddiadau*”) means the Welsh Health Specialised Services Committee (Wales) Directions 2009(2).

3. In Annex 1 of the principal Directions, the words “Emergency Ambulance Services” and “Emergency transport services for the sick and injured” are removed.
