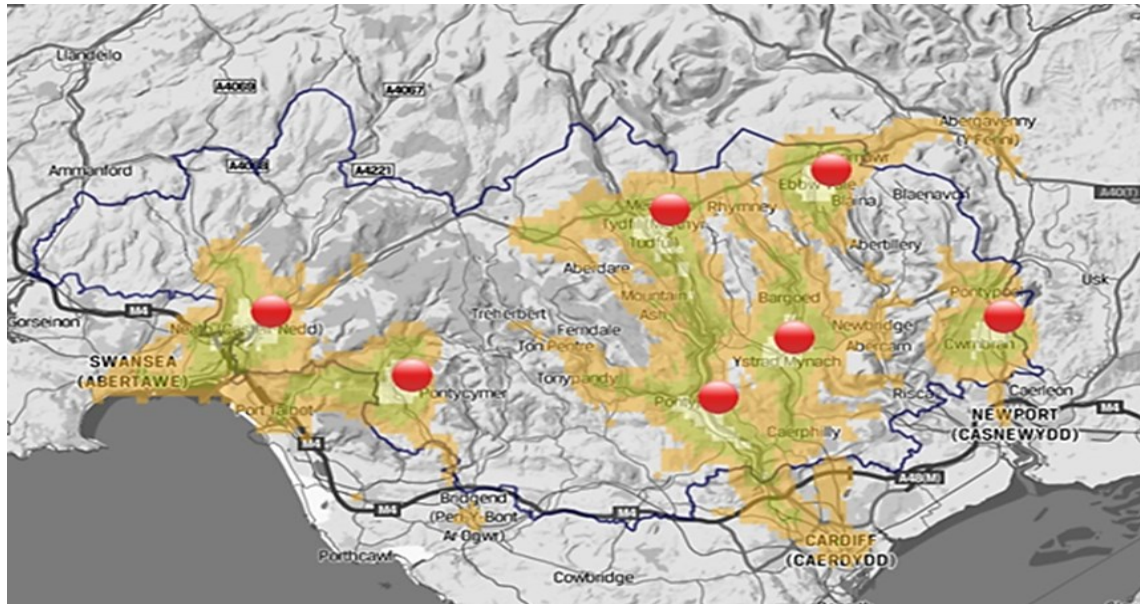

# Aim/Vision

**Strategic hubs** are areas of focused public sector investment, which aim to attract private sector investment, creating jobs and opportunities for the local area.

Seven areas across the South Wales Valleys have been identified as strategic hubs – these are areas which are most accessible within 45 minutes to people living within Valley communities by public transport



### **Northern Bridgend**

- Maesteg Town Hall - tourism and culture development
- Caero Project – renewable energy

### **Merthyr Tydfil**

- Integrated Transport Hub (Merthyr Bus Station)
- Town centre regeneration
- Valleys Life Dementia Hub
- Cyfartha Cultural, Heritage and Leisure Strategy

### **Neath**

- Crown Packaging Site – employment and factory space
- Town centre regeneration - retail mixed use development
- Homes as Power stations energy project
- Integrated Transport Hub (Neath)
- Acquisition, redevelopment of building for affordable homes

### **Ebbw Vale**

- Tech Valleys £100m investment over 10 years
- Rhyd Y Blew – 50,000 sqft Employment Space
- Lime Avenue Business Park – (JV) Employment Space
- Former Tech Board Unit – employment space & development site
- Residential developments

### **Pontypridd/ Treforest**

- Taff Vale site redevelopment – TfW occupation
- Dynamic Regional Hub – business space/tech hub
- Town centre regeneration
