The A470 Trunk Road (Bridge Street Interchange, Pontypridd, Rhondda Cynon Taf) (30 MPH Speed Limit and Removal of Prohibition of Pedestrians) Order 201-

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A470 Cardiff – Llangurig Trunk Road (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 84 (1) and (2) and 124 of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) (hereinafter referred to as “the 1984 Act”), and after consultation with the Chief Officer of the South Wales Police, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order comes into force on ***** 2012. The title to this Order is The A470 Trunk Road (Bridge Street Interchange, Pontypridd, Rhondda Cynon Taf) (30 MPH Speed Limit and Removal of Prohibition of Pedestrians) Order 2012.

2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in that length of the A470 Trunk Road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

3. The restriction imposed by this Order is in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment.

4. The Trunk Road (Glyntaff to Abercynon, Glamorgan) (Prohibition of Foot Passengers) Order 1973(2) is hereby revoked in respect of the lengths of the A470 Trunk Road specified in Schedule 2 to this

(Glyn-taf i Abercynon, Morgannwg) (Gwahardd Cerddwyr) 1973 (2) o ran y darnau hynny o Gefnffordd yr A470 a bennir yn Atodlen 2 i'r Gorchymyn hwn.

ii. that length of the southbound exit slip road from its junction with the Bridge Street Roundabout to a point 6 metres north of the said junction.

SCHEDULE 2

Removal of Prohibition of Pedestrians

i. that length of the northbound entry slip road from its junction with Bridge Street Roundabout to a point 30 metres north of the said junction.

ii. that length of the southbound exit slip road from its junction with Bridge Street Roundabout to a point 6 metres north of the said junction.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The proposed Order would relocate the existing 30 MPH speed limit and adjust the position of the current pedestrian prohibition, and is considered necessary in the interests of road safety to allow pedestrian movements between Pontypridd and the east side of the A470.
