Final Police Settlement 2020-21

This is to inform you of the Welsh Government's component of the Final Police Settlement for police forces in Wales for 2020-21, subject to approval by the National Assembly for Wales.

The Home Office has confirmed that all Welsh police forces will receive an increase in funding of 7.48% in 2020-21 compared with the current year. The Welsh Government contribution to the Settlement for Wales is £143.4 million.

Annex A contains details of the Final Settlement for each police force in Wales.

The Local Government Finance Report (No.2) 2020-21 (Final Settlement – Police and Crime Commissioners) published today is scheduled for debate in the National Assembly for Wales on 10 March 2020.
