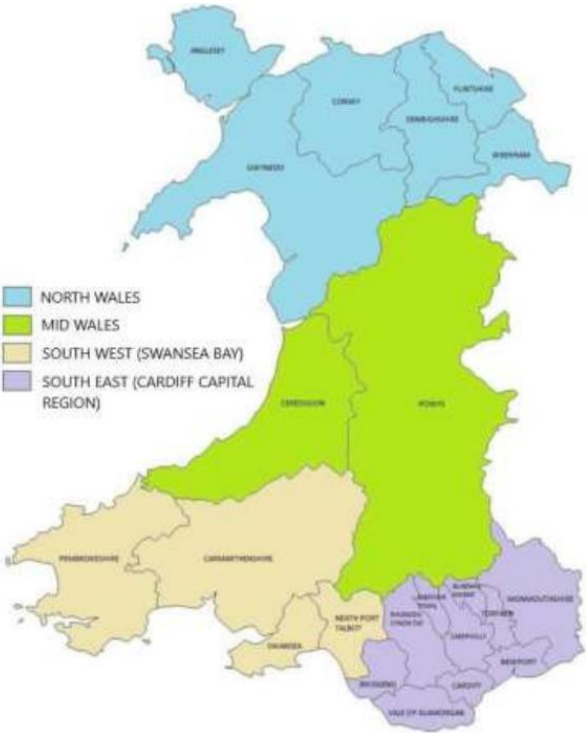

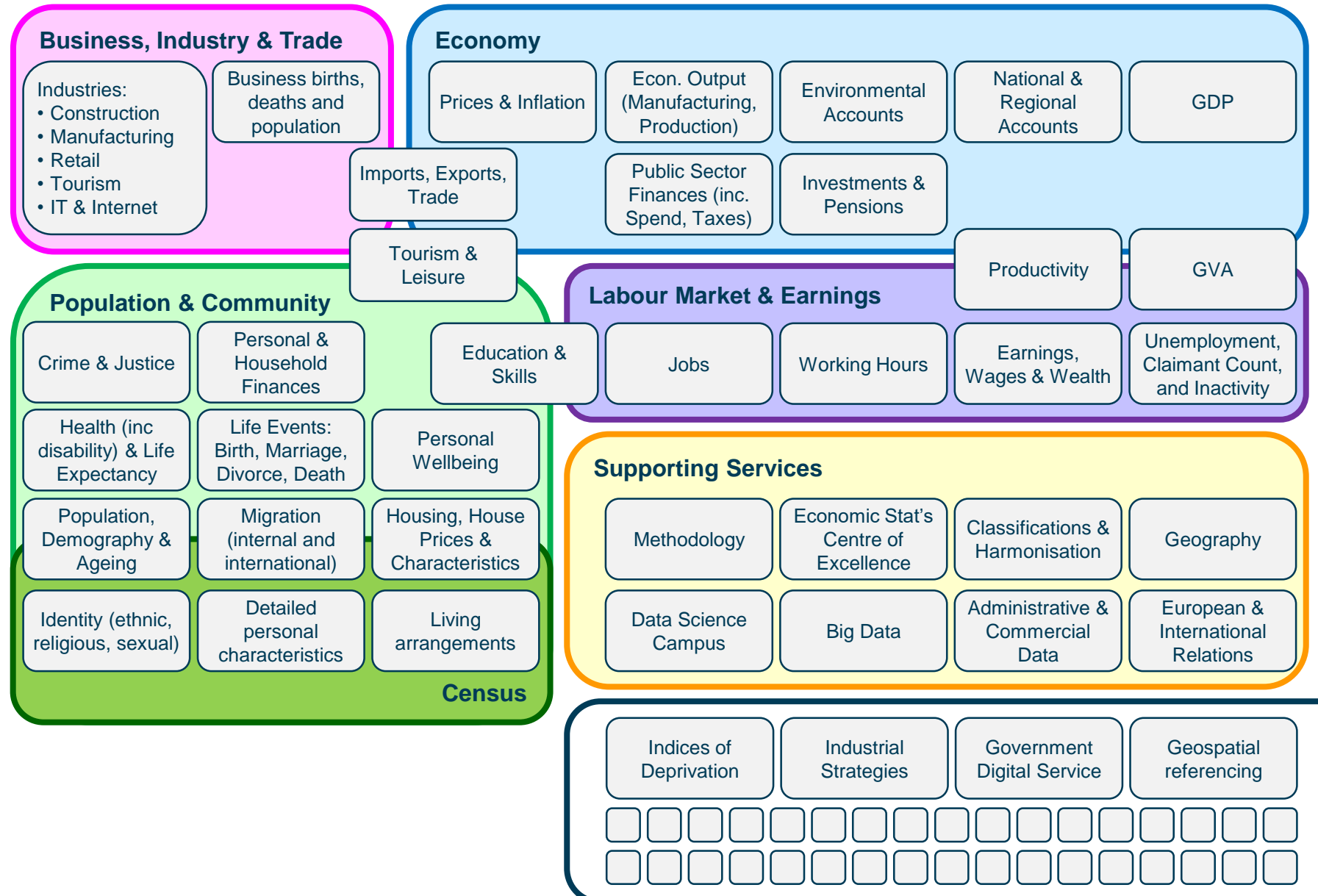

# Centre for Subnational Analysis

- Team of ~20 staff across ONS sites
- Includes sub-teams on:
  - Regional economic analysis
  - Spatial analysis
  - International engagement
  - Cities analysis
- Work across departments to drive delivery of analysis for smaller geographies across the UK

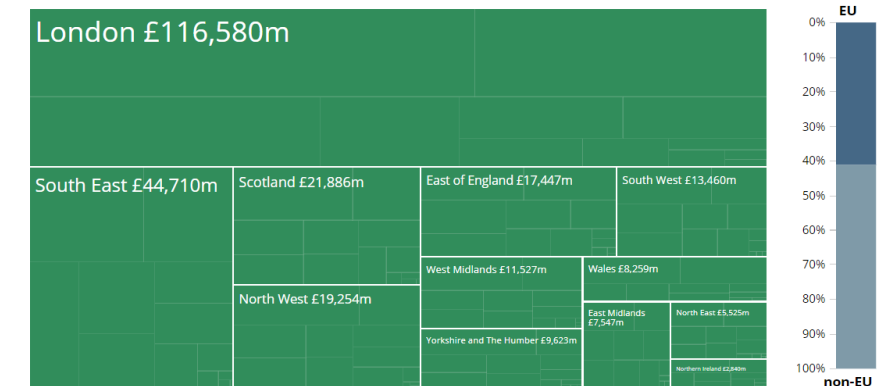

## Subnational service export results, 2017



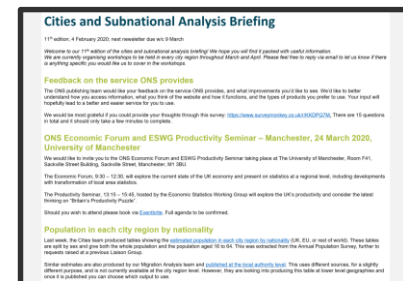

Please complete this template for the ONS Cities Analysis team to understand your requirements and act upon them as efficiently as possible. Be as specific and accurate as possible so we can generate the best outcomes. This is not an exhaustive document, so please add whatever detail you think is necessary.

<b>Who will ultimately use this output?</b> Examples: Mayor ; local authorities ; press office	
<b>When do you need this output?</b> Dates may be a publication, a press announcement, a public event, a foreign visit, a project launch, etc	
<b>Who should we work with to set definitions, agree deadlines and deliver results?</b> Please give name, email and full telephone number	
<b>What is the question you need to answer?</b> <b>What policy need does this inform?</b> <b>What statement or release are you making?</b> If possible include links or attach supporting info, especially if this is based upon a previous output	
<b>Where did this requirement come from?</b> Examples: manifesto ; annual update ; new policy	
<b>What variable(s) are you are interested in?</b> Examples: jobs ; employees ; residents ; number of businesses ; turnover ; total spend ; hourly wage ; percentage of employees earning less than £x	
<b>For what time period do you need this data?</b> Examples: latest year available ; 2006 to 2010 ; quarterly data for the last five years	
<b>For what geography do you need this data?</b> Examples: UK ; WM region ; local authorities within WMCA ; MSOAs ; "as low as possible"	
<b>On a residence basis or a workplace basis?</b> Many variables can be calculated based upon where people live (residence), like population or wealth, or where they work (workplace), like jobs or wages	
<b>Any other details, filters or breakdowns?</b> Examples: sex ; age groups ; ethnicity ; industry ; nationality ; occupation ; size of business	
<b>Do you know which data source should be used to conduct this analysis?</b> Examples: LFS/APS ; BRES ; ASHE ; IDBR ; etc	
<b>Any other details</b>	

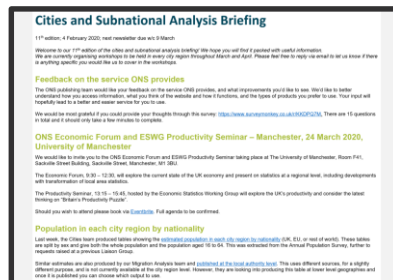
