Wales may be a small nation but we have big ambition.

Over the last 20 years Wales has been leading action in ensuring sustainability begins not just at home, but in our global actions.

We became the World's First Fair Trade Nation and have and will continue to help develop international networks and declarations.

Over the last 10 years we have built on this and continued to take action.

The Senedd Cymru Welsh Parliament agreed a set of seven sustainable well-being goals for Wales including one for 'A Globally Responsible Wales.


Environment Act – showing how the UN priorities can be implemented at a State and regional level including climate change targets, biodiversity duty and the sustainable management of natural resources.

Founding contributor to The Climate Groups Future Fund empowering developing and emerging economy regions to accelerate climate action.

Wales is the 1st Parliament in the World to declare a Climate Emergency.



Prosperity for All: A Low Carbon Wales – setting out 100 policies and proposals on how we are taking action to reduce our emissions.

Future Generations Commissioner for Wales became Chair of the Network of Institutions for Future Generations. Joined the international Powering Past Coal Alliance, focussing on the transition away from unabated coal power generation.
