# Animal and Environment Antimicrobial (AMR) Annual Review 2019/20



#### **Overview**

In 2019, the Minister for Environment, Energy and Rural Affairs published a five year **Antimicrobial Resistance, in Animals and the Environment, Implementation Plan for Wales**. This aligns with the UK Five Year Plan and 20 Year Vision.

The development and oversight of the Welsh Implementation Plan is supported by the **Animal and Environment AMR Delivery Group**, also established in 2019.

Everyone who keeps animals and uses antibiotics can contribute towards the plan and should take responsibility for its delivery.

# **Communication and Engagement**

A large focus has been to **coordinate activities** that are already taking place to join-up.

The CMO and the CVO, also supported **World Antibiotic Awareness Week**, by visiting a pharmacy and a veterinary practice.


## **Delivery**
