The request

Thank you for your request which I received on 11 November 2020. You asked for:

Details of the number of full-time or equivalent Welsh Government jobs across Wales. I would like the data provided as raw numbers and divided by local authority, based on ordinary place of work.

I would appreciate it if these figures could be provided as an Excel file or similar, not PDFs.

Our response

The attached file contains the information you have requested. It should be noted that although the locations refer to the permanent working base recorded against each member of staff, around 95% of Welsh Government staff have been working flexibly from home since March 2020, with a small number (5%) of staff attending one of our offices where there is an essential business or personal wellbeing need. This will continue to be the default position for the immediate future and we are not expecting the organisation to revert to pre-Covid ways of working over the longer term, or a return to the patterns of full time office-based working that we were used to before the global pandemic
