Please contact the Central Equine Database on info@equineregister.co.uk to update your details. You may need to ensure the passport details are also correct. Please contact your local Passport Issuing Organisation.

My horse(s) already has/have a microchip and passport. Do I need to do anything?

Please make sure the microchip details have been registered. You can use the National Equine Chip Checker to update your details. You may also need to ensure the microchip details are on the passport. **Please contact your local Passport Issuing Organisation.**

I don't currently have horses but I will buy more in the future. Do I need to do anything now?
