- Barnardo's Cymru and NSPCC offered help if parents were needed for focus groups throughout the campaign development.
- There was a general consensus that awareness raising amongst children should be embedded in the wider context of children's rights / ongoing activity / ongoing programmes – the general message was to keep it simple. It was agreed that the Expert Stakeholder Group would advise WG on raising awareness amongst children and young people.
- Stakeholders to share any resources that may be useful for engaging with children from previous projects and campaigns.
