

## **Objective 1**

Increase awareness and challenge attitudes of Violence Against Women, Domestic Abuse and Sexual Violence (VAWDASV) across the Welsh population. 2 campaign phases delivered: This is not OK
This is Sexual abuse



**44,000** unique page views to the **Live Fear Free** website during the campaign period.



9,800 interactions with the Live Fear Free helpline during the campaign period.

### **Objective 2**

Increased awareness in children and young people of the importance of safe, equal and healthy relationships and that abusive behaviour is always wrong.





VAWDASV guidance for Higher Education Institutions published.

**35,284** young people accessed heathy relationship awareness workshops via the **Spectrum project**.

## **Objective 3**

To increase focus on holding perpetrators to account, and to provide opportunities to change their behaviour based around victim safety.



Awarded £120,000 in grants to the seven regions to support them to improve the provision of perpetrator services in their areas.



8 practice sharing events, attended by 175 people, were held.

### **Objective 4**

Make early intervention and prevention a priority.

Supported both North Wales and Mid and West Wales' implementation of Ask and Act. An additional 1,000 people trained to Ask and Act.



3 Survivor engagement pilot panel sessions held, engaging with 12 survivors.
