## ATISN 14819 – Vaccination rollout

### Our Response

Thank you for your request to the Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) received on 28 January. You requested the following information –

*Details on the number of vaccinations that are wasted each day, particularly at the Haverfordwest, Cardigan and Carmarthen centres in the Hywel Dda Health Board.*

Welsh Government does not hold this information at the level of analysis requested. To clarify, we only hold this information at a Health Board and national level. I have provided a table below that provides you with the cumulative total of vaccines since 08 December 2020 which have been unable to be used for Hywel Dda Health Board.

(Doses which are unable to be used include those vials that fail QA on initial inspection, doses that fail QA following preparation and vials/ doses which expire during the vaccination session).
