Thank you for your email of 1 July on behalf of Llanidloes Without Community Council regarding passing places on the A470 from Llanidloes to Newtown.

The National Transport Finance Plan sets out our transport priorities to 2020. This Plan is kept under review and the delivery programme is managed to reflect changes in priorities and funding.

There is no specific commitment to introduce new passing places between Llanidloes and Newtown but there is a commitment in the Plan to identify a programme of improvements to improve journey time and reliability on the trunk network.

Unfortunately, neither I nor my officials will be able to attend any meetings. However, I would welcome further information from you as to the type of improvements the Council has in mind for this section of the A470.
