### **3. Location Update**

The first cut from MOJ estates colleagues of potential sites for the RWC has been received. There are a number of sites across the South Wales area and a review will be completed over the coming days. Properties on the list range from former care homes to office buildings which could be redeveloped. The list has been shared with the Estates team in Welsh Government who are discussing with their contacts to identify any other sites. Initial assessments will begin this week. The aim is early in new year to identify a short list of sites to investigate in more detail. If the board has any further information on potential sites they are asked to share with [REDACTED].

At the recent roundtable, the Minister discussed the services that we are planning to provide and the need to think about the interventions that will be delivered. The Minister said she would take away the discussions around assessment and preparation and managing the women's entry into the RWC. Talked about the RWC principals and the RWC being a trauma informed environment. Comments were made around drugs, children and move on. Whether women who are going through detox should come into the RWC and how to make this work was also raised. Safeguarding of children and the need to provide a service for children and a full package for families was discussed.
